Dear families and Friends,

Reading at Home

Thank you to everyone who connected online last night for a short workshop about how you can support your children with their reading at home. At this workshop, the school's new decodable books were shown, including a page in the back of them that provides additional information and quick activities that you can have your children do to support them with their reading at home. At the conclusion of the workshop, the following ideas were provided to summarise what you can do to support reading at home.

1. Talk with your kids (a lot)
2. Read to your kids (a lot)
3. Have your kids retell stories they have read
4. Focus on phonemic awareness – recognising that words are made up of sounds
5. Focus on letter sounds and names
6. Listen to your child read
7. Promote exploratory writing
8. Ask questions
9. Make reading a regular activity in your home

Ultimately, the best thing that you can do to support your children with reading at home is to show an interest in it and its importance. We want kids at Wooragee to not only practise decoding (working out the words) and comprehension skills, but to also develop a love and passion for reading. We can't do this without you!
