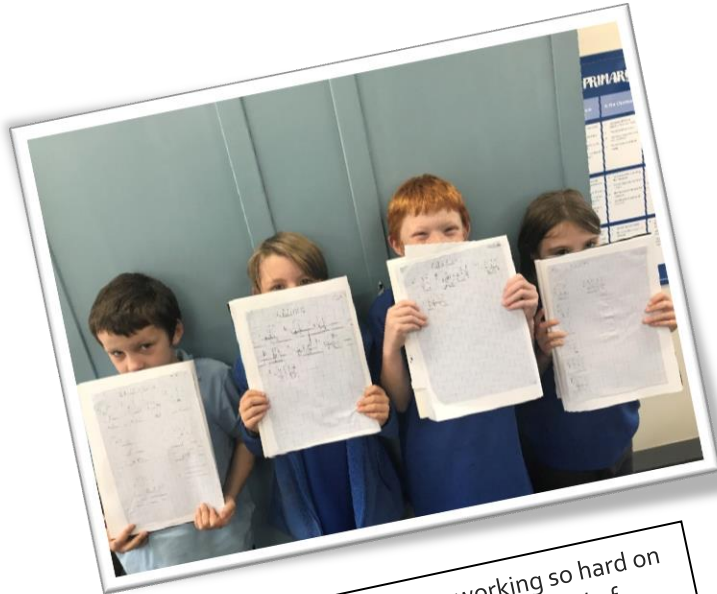
### STUDENT WORK

**Dead Meat**

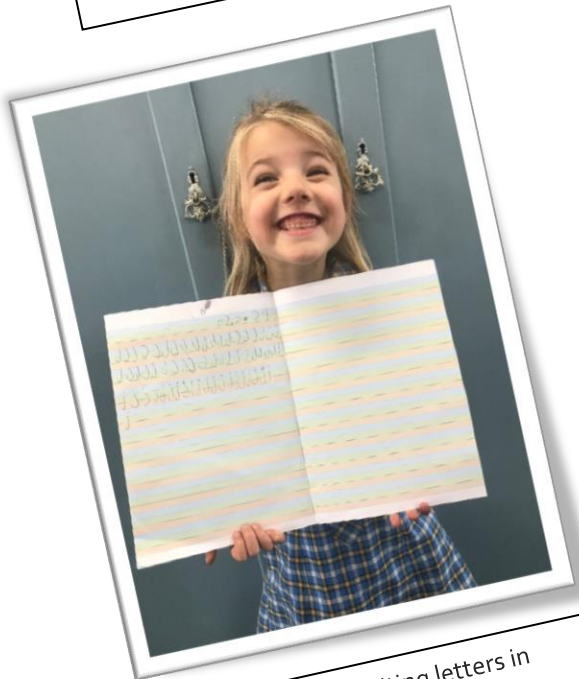
A story that will leave you on the edge of your seat. Are you ready for gore, aircraft and exciting hiking adventures, you are in for a surprise.



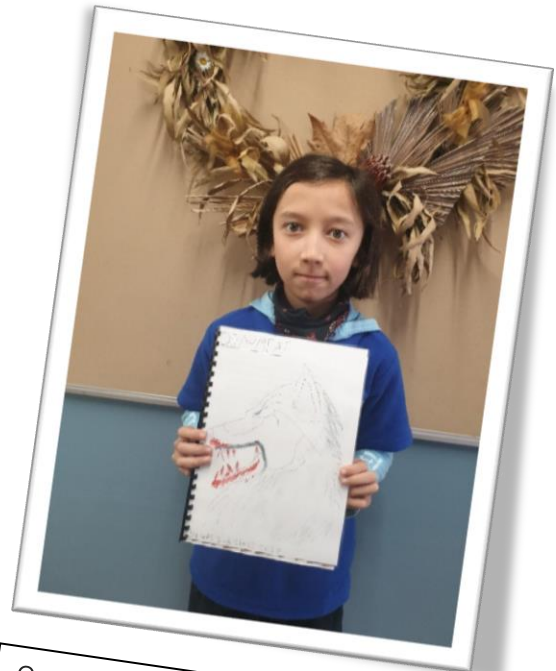
Jess: These four having been working so hard on addition! On this day, they were so proud of themselves.
